



AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION BETWEEN THE INSTITUTION OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS
AND THE INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS OF JAPAN

In recognition of their wish for mutual collaboration, the Institution of Electrical Engineers and the Institute of Electrical Engineers of Japan (hereafter referred to as "reciprocal societies") have entered into an "Agreement on Cooperation" as follows:

- (a) Visiting members from reciprocal societies will be granted equivalent facilities to those granted to local members. In effect this will enable such visitors to take advantage of special member rates for attending lectures and conferences and to use the library, members' reading room and other facilities. The Secretary of either reciprocal society will, on request, provide a letter of introduction and confirm the membership of the visiting member.
- (b) For stays abroad for longer than one year, members of a reciprocal society will be expected to join the society of the country in which they are residing.
- (c) Members of reciprocal societies are eligible to receive certain publications at reduced rates of subscription.
 - i) In the case of periodicals for which a reduced subscription rate is available to members, the reduction available to members of reciprocal societies shall be 20% of the non members price.
 - ii) In the case of single copy publications for which a reduced price is available to members, the publication shall be available to members of reciprocal societies at the same price as to members.
- (d) By mutual agreement certain publications may be exchanged with similar publications of the reciprocal society.
- (e) Reciprocal societies may be invited to co-sponsor conferences on a case to case basis.
- (f) Consultation shall take place when it is proposed to mount an event (eg, a conference) by one reciprocal society in the country of the other.
