AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS PAKISTAN

AND

THE INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS OF JAPAN

The Institution of Engineers Pakistan and The Institute of Electrical Engineers of Japan (hereinafter referred to as both sides), for the purpose of upgrading the academic standards in the field of electrical engineering of Pakistan and Japan, strengthening the mutual understanding and ties and developing the academic exchanges and technical cooperative relations between both sides, have agreed as follow:

ARTICLE 1

Both sides agree to conduct technical cooperation in the following ways:

- 1. Exchanging technical periodicals of common interest.
- 2. By mutual agreement specialists, scholars, scientific and technical personnel may be sent to carry out professional investigations, to take part in symposia and seminars and for advanced study.
- 3. By mutual agreement making common researches, exchanging research results and experiences on items of common interest according to circumstances; exchange of researchers and professors according to circumstances.
- 4. Joint symposia and seminars may be organized upon occasion.
- 5. Other forms of scientific and technical cooperation agreed on both sides.

ARTICLE 2

Both sides agree to cooperate in all fields of electrical engineering. The IEEJ contributions will be mainly in the areas covered by its technical divisions:

- 1. Fundamentals and Materials
- 2. Power and Energy
- 3. Electronics, Information and Systems
- 4. Industrial Applications
- 5. Sensor Micromachine

ARTICLE 3

By mutual agreement both sides will meet irregularly according to needs for drawing up coordinating the activities specified in the Agreement, the venue being in Pakistan and Japan by rotation. The date of meeting will be negotiated specifically by both sides.

ARTICLE 4

The payment of the cost of cooperative activities will be done on the basis of reciprocity and equality in following way.

Traveling expenses to and from the country of the sending personnel and the costs of accommodation, meals and other expenses during the visit in the receiving country will be borne by the sending party (including the cost of transportation in that country).

ARTICLE 5

This agreement is subject to revision or supplement after negotiations by both sides.
