



AGREEMENT OF CO-OPERATION

between

and

The Institution of Engineers (India) 8 Gokhale Road, Kolkata 700 020, India

hereinafter called IEI

PREAMBLE

The IEEJ and IEI have entered into this Agreement of Co-operation to promote and enlarge the exchange of technical, scientific and professional knowledge to better serve the interests and welfare of their members, the engineering profession in general, and the public in both countries. The spirit of this Agreement is to encourage and support engineer members of the partner organizations to uphold and advance the integrity, honour and dignity of the engineering profession by using their knowledge and skill for the enhancement of human welfare; by being honest and impartial and serving with fidelity the public, their employers and clients; by striving to increase the competence and prestige of the engineering profession; and by supporting the professional and technical societies of their disciplines.





2.0 SCOPE

- 2.1 This Agreement covers the activities of IEEJ in Japan and the activities of IEI in India; both organizations are also willing to work together on international issues wherever deemed appropriate.
- The spirit of this Agreement is to encourage and support engineer members of the partner organizations to uphold and advance the integrity, honour and dignity of the engineering profession by using their knowledge and skill for the enhancement of human welfare; by being honest and impartial and serving with fidelity the public, their employers and clients; by striving to increase the competence and prestige of the engineering profession; and by supporting the professional and technical societies of their disciplines.

3.0 AIMS estions to the same degree as provided to

- 3.1 Exchange of information regarding the engineering profession in general listed below:
 - Republishing of articles, papers and information under preferred terms and in accordance with an agreement specific to each case, provided appropriate measures are taken to identify authors, protect their rights, and if required, obtain prior permission of authors.
 - Encouragement of the exchange of monthly magazines so that both organizations may establish and maintain depositories of technical monthly magazines.
 - Exchange of information regarding scientific and technical events which are of mutual interest.
 - Exchange of technical periodicals and other publications and if these are not in English, then
 English catalogues or English abstracts should be attached.
- 3.2 Encouragement of joint events of all kinds such as seminars, workshops, and technical meetings.
- 3.3 Encouragement of the exchange of lecturers and guests.
- 3.4 Each organization shall extend to the members of the partner organization, including student members, the same privileges and courtesies as extended to its own members at same dues rates and costs during a temporary (three years or less) stay in the country of the other partner, if so requested by a member.





4.0 SERVICES TO STUDENT MEMBERS AND GUEST MEMBERS

- 4.1 IEEJ and IEI will extend student membership privileges to student members of the partner organization who are studying in an engineering, technical or scientific field, at the same dues rates, during temporary stays in the partner organization's country.
 - Student members of one organization making a presentation at student competitions of the guest organization shall be judged by the same criteria as those of the host organization, but shall not be eligible for host organization prizes.
- 4.2 Both partners will provide advice to guest students and guest members on questions of education and training as well as professional questions to the same degree as provided to their own members.

5.0 JOINT MEMBERSHIP

Joint membership in both organizations is encouraged, and each organization will endeavour to facilitate this. Members of one organization who meet the membership requirements of the other organization may apply for the membership of that organization.

6.0 EXECUTIVE, DURATION AND AMENDMENT

- 6.1 This Agreement will become valid after it has been approved by the governing bodies of both organizations and signed by authorized officers thereof.
- 6.2 The Agreement has a fixed duration of three years, whereupon it will automatically be renewed for another three years if not terminated by either organization.
- 6.3 The Agreement may be terminated at any time prior to the date of expiration with six months' written notice by either organization.
- 6.4 In the implementation of this Agreement, any supplemental agreement in accordance with the articles of this Agreement shall be subject to mutual agreement before entered into by the respective Presidents of IEEJ and IEI.
- 6.5 Amendments to the Agreement may be made at any time, but shall be mutually confirmed in writing by both organizations.
